

DOULTING PARISH COUNCIL

Restrictions on the use of The Glebeland as defined in the Second Schedule (clauses 1 and 3) of the restrictive covenants in the Agreement applying to The Glebeland.

- 1) The Glebeland is defined as a public open space and therefore cannot be fenced or sectioned off for private use or access restricted by the sale of tickets and control of access.
- 2) Any form of alcohol cannot be sold in The Glebeland and any form of drunken, outrageous or nuisance behaviour is not permitted.

In addition to the above, the Parish Council has agreed that:

- 3) Only barbeques raised off the ground on legs can be used in The Glebeland, the use of any form of disposable barbeque is not permitted.
