

DOULTING PARISH

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 21st MAY 2025 AT DOULTING VILLAGE HALL COMMENCING AT 7pm.

1	<u>Chairmans welcome.</u> Cllr Baker welcomed all present to the meeting. Two parish councillors and three members of the public were present.
2	<u>Apologies for absence.</u> Cllr Goff and two members of the public.
3	<u>Acceptance of the Minutes of the previous meeting:</u> Minutes of the meeting held on 9 th May 2024 were taken as read and signed as a true record.
4	<u>Matters Arising from the Minutes of the meeting:</u> No matters were raised.
5	<u>Chairmans Report:</u> Cllr Baker thanked the clerk and councillors for their work during the past year. He thanked Mary Newman for her continuing works especially with The Glebeland and those regular members of the public who attended Parish Council meetings. He noted that the matter of devolved services from Somerset were still unresolved and that the Parish Council was now responsible for payments in respect of bin emptying for around £1700 per year. The Parish Council was still querying the way in which the decision about the Doultling Quarry extension was reached and was continuing to take the matter up with Somerset.
6	<u>Unitary Council Reports:</u> No specific report for this meeting had been received.
7	<u>Other reports as received.</u> No further reports were received.
8	<u>Meeting open to the public and parishioners.</u> A question about Parish Assets being taken over by another council was asked. The clerk advised that he knew of nothing which affected those assets under Parish Council control. There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.25pm
